Frequently Asked Questions

When and where is this year's NBMBAA® Annual Conference?

The 2020 Conference & Career Fair will be fully virtual and will take place online from Sept. 23-25, 2020.

How can I register for the Virtual Event?

Once registration opens, visit the registration page at www.nbmbaa.org/conference.

What is the registration cost for the virtual event?

Standard Pass (Career Fair only)

Members: \$129 (after 9/20/20: \$159)

Non-Members: \$299 (after 9/20/20: \$329)

Premium Pass (Career Fair and Educational Sessions)

Members: \$229 (after 9/20/20: \$259)

Non-Members: \$399 (after 9/20/20: \$429)

How do I join NBMBAA® to receive a registration discount?

Visit the member page at <https://nbmbaa.org/registration/> to complete your membership purchase. Be sure to use the email address on your membership when you register for the event.

I am on the Member Installment Plan. What if I miss a payment?

Your membership must be paid through the year for your registration discount to be maintained. If you miss a payment or your credit card fails, you will be required to pay your membership in full in order to receive login credentials for the event.

When and where do I access the virtual event?

A link will be provided via email in advance of the event. The event will open Sept. 23, 2020. Additional details on system requirements, internet requirements and other suggestions will be provided through the summer.

Do I need special software for the virtual event?

No, but there are some system requirements for you to have to best experience. Late this summer, we will be sending out system requirements for your computer and internet connection. You will also be able to run a system check to ensure things will run smoothly.

Will there be interviewing at the virtual event?

Yes, corporate partners will conduct on-site interviewing (by chat and video conference).

How do I get an interview?

Corporate Partners will post job and pre-screen résumés for interviews this summer. Visit careersuccess.nbmbaa.org or follow the link on your registration confirmation to visit the NBMBAA Career Success Network® job board, upload your current résumé, apply for current jobs and contact employers.

Do I have to post my résumé in advance?

No, but we highly recommend you post it **as soon as possible** if you are job seeking. Recruiters will be looking at candidates all summer.

What if I don't post my résumé in advance?

Employers will not be able to find you to offer pre-scheduled interviews. You will still be able to upload your résumé on the event day for consideration, but you will not have interviews set up in advance and will have to rely on whatever chats/interviews you can secure on the fly during the event days.

What is the difference between the Standard Pass (Career Fair only), the Premium Pass (Full Conference)?

The Standard Pass (Career Fair only), includes access only to the Lobby, Expo halls and Lounge.

The Premium Pass (Full Conference) includes access to everything from the Standard Pass, plus all regular Conference programming (Breakout Sessions, Leadership Studios and Keynotes).

Are there any pre-Conference courses this year?

No, pre-Conference courses are not being offered this year.

Do you have a student discount?

Discounts are only offered to members. Students can join and register for member discounts. Non-member students are subject to non-member rates.

I am exhibitor or sponsor. How do I register?
